



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who is eligible to apply?

The WYA Asia Pacific Summer Camp is open to all applicants within the age of 15- 25 years old. We highly encourage high school students, university students, and recent graduates to apply.

2. How many people apply? What are the chances of my application being successful?

We receive many applications, and the selection is based on honest, sincere and prepared applications. It is not based on chance or the order in which we receive them.

3. What is the daily schedule like?

Camp starts daily at 7:30 AM and ends around 8:00 PM. We tackle two chapters of the Certified Training Program (CTP) each day with activities interspersed in between discussions. We also give an allotted free time for the campers to do other activities like swimming or sports as long as they're done with their CTP Answers.

4. What is the Certified Training Program?

The Certified Training Program (Track A) is designed to provide a brief but comprehensive training in the context, ideas, and work of the World Youth Alliance. Any WYA Member or Friend interested in participating in WYA programs must complete this training in order to grasp the mission and vision that the organization embraces. These activities include: the International Internship Program, creating a WYA Chapter, participating in conferences and commissions by the UN and other international organizations, attending WYA's International Solidarity Forum, and others.

5. Can WYA Asia Pacific accommodate applicants with special needs?

As of now, our camp facilitators are not equipped to take care of participants with special needs.





6. Do you have a scholarship program?

We currently cannot provide scholarship funding for our applicants, but WYA Asia Pacific is already subsidizing a part of the campers' fee. Also note that the fee, once paid, is non-refundable.

7. Can campers request roommates?

The camp facilitators will be the one assigning roommates based on sex and age range.

8. Do we have internet connection during camp?

Yes, there is internet connection at the hotel lobby, and cellphone signal inside the rooms. However, the WYA Summer Camp encourages its campers to unplug themselves from their gadgets for a few days and be present in the moment in order to take full advantage of the camp.

9. Can we bring our electronic gadgets during the camp?

You may bring your gadgets to camp but the facilitators and hotel administration will not be responsible in case they get lost or broken during the activities.

10. What if I want to explore the Philippines before or after the Summer Camp?

For our international participants, we highly encourage you to stay in the Philippines for a couple more days to explore the different tourist destinations the Philippines offers. However, expenses incurred before and after the summer camp will be the sole responsibility of the participants. Our WYA camp facilitators will not be held responsible in booking your flights or hotel accommodations.
